



Measure of the Dean of the Faculty of Economics No. 307E dated 21. 7. 2026

On the conditions for reducing the tuition fee for study in a doctoral study programme taught in a foreign language in the combined form of study in the academic year 2026/2027

Article 1 Introductory Provisions

- 1) This measure regulates the conditions for the reduction of the tuition fee for study in the combined form of a doctoral study programme taught in a foreign language pursuant to Article 5(5) of the Rector's Measure of the University of South Bohemia No. R 629 on determining tuition fees associated with study for the academic year 2026/2027.
- 2) This measure applies to students of doctoral study programmes offered by the Faculty of Economics of the University of South Bohemia in České Budějovice in a foreign language.
- 3) This measure applies only to the academic year 2026/2027.

Article 2 Outstanding Fulfilment of Study Obligations

- 1) For the purposes of this measure, outstanding fulfilment of study obligations shall mean active publication and research activity carried out under the supervision of the supervisor, as specified in paragraph 2.
- 2) The condition under paragraph 1 shall be considered fulfilled if, by the end of the winter semester of the academic year 2026/2027, i.e. by 14 February 2027, the student has submitted:
 - a) at least one scholarly article to a journal indexed in Web of Science, or
 - b) at least two scholarly articles to journals indexed in Scopus,and the journal's editorial board has accepted the article(s) for the peer-review process.



This shall not apply if the Subject-Area Board concludes that the journal concerned is a so-called predatory journal.

- 3) The relevant condition under paragraph 2 shall be considered fulfilled only if the article includes only affiliation with the Faculty of Economics of the University of South Bohemia.
- 4) Fulfilment of this condition shall be evaluated by the Subject-Area Board during its assessment of the winter semester of study, based on documents submitted by the student, including the relevant article and an overview of previous communication with the respective journal.
In exceptional cases, the Subject-Area Board may propose, and the Dean may subsequently approve, that the student has fulfilled their study obligations in an outstanding manner even in cases other than those specified in paragraph 2.

Article 3

Reduction of the Tuition Fee

- 1) A student who has fulfilled their study obligations in an outstanding manner during the winter semester pursuant to Article 2 and who, according to the evaluation of the Subject-Area Board in the given semester, has also fulfilled all obligations stipulated in the individual study plan, shall have the tuition fee for study in a doctoral study programme taught in a foreign language reduced to EUR 1,000.
- 2) Fulfilment of the conditions under Article 2 shall be assessed mainly on the basis of:
 - a) evaluation of the fulfilment of the individual study plan,
 - b) supervisor's statement,
 - c) documented publication outputs or confirmation of acceptance for publication.
- 3) In the case of a student for whom fulfilment of the conditions under Article 2 of this measure during the academic year can reasonably be expected, the Dean may, upon the student's request, decide in advance on the assessment of the tuition fee in the reduced amount pursuant to paragraph 1.

Article 4

Final Provisions

- 1) This measure shall enter into force on the date of its publication in the public section of the Faculty of Economics website of the University of South Bohemia.
