



DEAN'S NOTIFICATION No. 199/2025 E

The amount and conditions for awarding basic doctoral scholarships to students of full-time doctoral study programs at the FE USB for the academic year of 2025/2026

1 September 2025

Article 1 Introductory provisions

This notification from the dean is valid only for students enrolled in studies before March 1, 2025, who have not been awarded a compensatory scholarship in accordance with Appendix 3 of Dean's Measure No. 215/2022 to ensure studies in doctoral study programs.

Article 2 Scholarship

For the academic year of 2025/2026 and in accordance with Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on universities and on the amendment and addition of other laws (the Higher Education Act), in accordance with the Scholarship Regulations, all as amended, the amount of scholarship for students of the full-time doctoral program in Czech and English is set at CZK 13,000 per month. The scholarship is paid for 12 months during the standard period of study in the academic year in accordance with the schedule of the academic year.

Article 2 Scholarship Reduction

1. This amount will be reduced in the event that a student does not properly and timely fulfill their study obligations specified in their individual study plan (ISP). The reduction is effected as follows, the scholarship amount is reduced by CZK 1,000 for each unpassed subject enrolled in the relevant academic year.

2. Furthermore, the Study Field Committee (SFC) may propose to the dean of the faculty a reduction or withdrawal of a scholarship in the event of non-fulfillment of study obligations in accordance with the Measure of the Dean No. 215/2022 to ensure studies in doctoral study programs and the Measure of the Dean No. 219/2022 on obligations of doctoral students at FE of USB in České Budějovice.

Article 3 Scholarship Increase

1. The amount of the scholarship specified in Article 2 will be increased by CZK 1,000 per month for each completed subject that a student successfully completes ahead of their individual study plan, always starting at the beginning of the following month of the given academic year, after submitting an application to the Department of Science and Research at the FE USB. This increase lasts for the standard period of study.



2. An increase in the scholarship will not be granted for the completion of a subject that was unenrolled in the course of study in accordance with the Measure of the Dean of the FE No. 229/2022, Addendum No. 1 to Measure of the Dean of the FE No. 215/2022.

Article 4 One-time Scholarship Increase

The amount of the scholarship specified in Article 2 will be increased, based on a review by the Study Field Committee for the doctoral study program, once by:

- a) an amount up to CZK 4,000 for each reviewed scientific publication with IF published during the doctoral studies;
- b) an amount up to CZK 2,000 for each reviewed scientific publication included in the SCOPUS database;
- c) the amount of CZK 2,000 for solving an individual GAJU research project within the USB,
- d) an amount of CZK 4,000 for being a researcher or co-researcher of a research project outside the USB (applies only to projects registered in the CEP).

A one-time increase in the scholarship will be paid after the relevant output has been entered into the OBD database, which is provided by the student in coordination with the relevant department and after submitting an application to the Department of Science and Research.

Article 5 Repeated Increase

In the event that a student removes the deficiencies that were the reason for the reduction of the basic amount of the scholarship, the relevant amount will be awarded to them, based on the student's written request submitted to the Department of Science and Research of the Faculty of Economics of the University of South Bohemia in České Budějovice, at the earliest possible payment date.
